Chasseurs de Moçambique is a Moçambique registered Safari Company that offers the big



HUNTING AREAS



NIASSA

Niassa is located in the most Northern part of Moçambique bordering Tanzania. The Rovuma River forms the border between Moçambique and Tanzania and the Northern boundary from the hunting area. The Niassa Safari areas are primarily used for buffalo, leopard, lion and plains game species where we average a 100% success rate on these species. The hunting areas total in excess of 2 million acres of pristine free-range wilderness area. Access to these blocks is easily accessible via commercial airline direct to Lichinga or Pemba. Charter flights can be arranged direct to camp from Johannesburg or Maputo.

TETE

Our hunting block within Tete province lies on the banks of the Zambezi River. Located 1 hour from Tete International Airport, this area is easily accessible. Catering for monster crocodile and hippo with limited buffalo, leopard and plains game makes this hunting block an affordable option to add on to our Niassa safaris. This hunting area totals 250000 acres in size. Travelling to this area is done done with a direct flight from Johannesburg to Tete International Airport.

ZAMBEZI DELTA

The famous Zambezi Delta is located where the might Zambezi River flows into the Indian Ocean. Access to this area is made easy with a direct flight to Beira and then using a charter to get into camp. This area is mainly used for buffalo and plains game with a total buffalo heard of 30 000 in numbers. The Zambezi Delta offers a wide range of plains game species, from the tiny ten up to buffalo, hippo and crocodile.

ZIMBABWE

Our hunting areas in Zimbabwe are in Gwanda and Matetsi, Eastern Block. Gwanda ECU is situated south-west of Bulawayo bordering Botswana close to the Shashe River. It's a very large stretch of land with plenty elephant and leopard.



SAFARI INFORMATION

HUNTING SEASON

The Moçambique hunting season starts in May and ends in November.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Safaris are confirmed on receipt of 50% of the total daily rate plus the hunting license and gov. license fee of the species chosen in order to secure the safari. The balance of the daily rate plus additional charges are payable 0 days prior to the commencement of the safari and the trophy fees are payable at the conclusion of the safari. Payment in camp must be made in cash or by bank transfers prior to the safari commencing. Please note: all prices exclude 17% VAT.

CANCELLATION POLICY

There will be no refund on any deposit paid, unless the hunt is cancelled no less than 180 days prior to the commencement of the safari and 1000 US Dollars will be deducted for administration expenses. See hunting contract for more details.

IDEMNITY

Due to the nature of the safari hunting activity in wild conditions, Chasseurs de Moçambique, their employees, guides and affiliates, do not accept responsibility for any client or dependant thereof in respect of any loss, injury, illness, damage, accident, fatality, delay or inconvenience experienced.

INSURANCE

Clients should arrange their own travel, medical and accidental insurance. We accept no liabilities whatsoever in regard to: weather conditions, injuries or damage to persons and/or equipment.

PASSPORT & VISAS

Customs clearance is operative at your port of entry in Moçambique. You must have a passport, valid for a miniumum of 6 months beyond intended departure from Moçambique and have two blank pages in your passport. All non-Moçambique citizens MUST have a visa. Please ensure that your visa is valid at least a week before and week after the contracted period. For more accurate information please consult the official authorities.





DAILY RATES INCLUDE

- · East African tented style accommodation in fully equipped private hunting camps.
 - \cdot The services of a PH (Professional Hunter).
 - · Fully equipped 4x4 safari vehicles.
 - · Camp staff, skinners and tracking service.
 - · All field preparation of trophies.
 - · All ground transport in the hunting area.
- · All meals and standard drinks during contracted safari (accordingly with company policy).
 - · Meet and greet customs assistance at port of entry.
 - · Government concession fess, community and conservation fees.

DAILY RATES EXCLUDE:

- · Animal license fees.
- · Animal trophy fees (to be paid on all animals killed or wounded and lost).
 - · Lion and leopard baits.
 - · The cost of hunting license and firearm permits.
 - · The hire of firearms and ammunition.
- · Tanning, processing, packaging and transportation of trophies for exportation.
 - \cdot Transfers from airpot to base camp and back.
 - · Hotel accommodation before and after the hunt, if applicable.



SAFARI INFORMATION



TROPHY EXPORTATION

Trophies are exported once at the end of the season before end of November. We take the trophies to a central point in Tete where the exporters collect it and then further prepare for export to various countries of the clients residence address.

We currently make use of EMIAC or Safari Cargo Systems. It is the clients choice which company he wants to use.

For the mounting of trophies we use Field and Stream Taxidermy in South Africa. If the client decides he want to make use of this service, we will ship his trophies through Safari Cargo Systems to Field and Stream Taxidermy in Louis Trichardt in South Africa for mounting.

Either of these companies will get in touch with the clients for export / mounting instructions directly to ensure they deliver the best possible serves. Please do keep in mind, all these companies are independent service providers and we try to ensure we use just the best service providers known to us.

The following must reach us at least 90 days prior to the safari starting date:

- · A complete trophy list for each hunter (in order to obtain the relevant trophy permits)
 - · 2 passport photos of each hunter
 - · Full residential details of each hunter
 - · A photocopy of each hunter's passport's main pages
- · Full details with regards to: make, serial number, caliber of each firearm/s and the number of ammo of each caliber
 - · Ammo: only 100 rounds allowed per caliber
 - · The photographs may be taken digitally
 - · The passport copies may be scanned and both can be emailed to us
 - · The required deposit and the funds for licenses and firearm permits.

We make every effort to ensure that our clients are fully aware of all costs involved on each hunt to avoid surprises.

Note! No traveler's checks and no U.S. dollar bills issued before 2001 or U.S. dollars bills with "small Presidential heads" will be accepted in Moçambique! (Reserve Bank Rules).

MARANGIRA (HUNTING IN NORTHERN MOZAMBIQUE)

We hunt 988 000 acres of pristine wilderness in the Niassa province – North- western Mozambique. The area is situated north of the small town, Marrupa and south of Block C – Niassa Reserve. The concession (hunting Safari area) is flanked on the left by the Ruambeze and on the west by Lureco rivers.

The main habitat is Miombo woodland with some open Savannah areas, seasonal wetlands and riverine forests along the many water courses, rivers, and streams.

The landscape is scattered with spectacular rock formations and mountains, many of them have thickets of montane forest growing in the narrow gullies that extend up the smooth – sided rock faces.

The magnificent scenery combined with the vastness of the area abundance of game and pristine nature makes this without a doubt one of Africa's last great wilderness areas.

Our Marangira area is home to prolific wildlife, including Elephant and more than 60 of the critically endangered African Wild Dog. Leopard is also found in abundance, along with Lion and Hyena. Here you will also find large numbers of Buffalo, Roosevelt Sable, Lichtenstein's Hartebeest and Livingstone's Eland including three endemic species, Boehm's Zebra, Johnstone's Impala and Niassa Wildebeest.

Niassa province is in the far North-Western region of Moçambique and it shares the 9th largest freshwater lake of Malawi and also borders Tanzania. It has an area of 47 423 square miles and a population of just over 1 million, which makes Niassa the most sparsely populated province in the country.

Most of this province is untouched by development with about a quarter of the province being a National Park. Lichinga is the Capital of Niassa Province.

Niassa is now one of Africa's best hunting locations.

In general, an exceptional trophy quality goes hand in hand with high populations of game.
